CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J.M. Ward and J. H. Smith by J. H. Smith has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Twin Springs

through pipe line to troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 Sec. 9, T. 33 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M.; or N. 2 1/4 E., 1150 feet and N. 2 1/4 E., 1300 feet respectively from the 1/4 corner of Secs. 8 & 9 T. 33 N., R. 20 E., M. D. B. & M., situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator J. M. Ward and J. H. Smith
Post-office address Reno, Washoe County, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.006 C.F.S. or sufficient to water 200 head of cattle and horses.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation May 6, 1925

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of Use:
Ten feet of 1 inch pipe conveys water from No. 1 Spring to a galvanized iron trough 24 inches by 14 inches by 10 feet long and 10 feet of 2 inch pipe conveys water from No. 2 spring to a wooden trough 18 inches by 18 inches by 12 feet long. These springs are 150 feet apart and are located in the SW 1/4 Sec. 9, T. 33 N., R. 20 E., the water from which is used for the watering of 200 head of cattle and horses.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
