CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS F. W. Racey, Supt. Tonopah Belmont Co. has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from California Mill Spring No. 2 through Nevada-Belmont Pipe line for Mining-Milling and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 Sec. 6, T. 16 N., R. 58 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point which bears N. 4° 00' W., 1415 ft. distant from SE Cor. of sec. 6, T. 16 N., R. 58 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Francis Cutting Co.

Amount of appropriation 0.013 of a cubic foot per second.
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 21, 1926.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted and conveyed from spring in the NE 1/4 Sec. 6, T. 16 N., R. 58 E., M.D.B. & M., by means of a 2 inch pipeline for a distance of 450 feet, thence through 3200 feet of 2 1/2 inch pipe and 10,100 feet of 3 inch pipe as common carrier to the place of use in the SW 1/4 Sec. 1, T. 16 N., R. 57 E., M.D.B. & M., where it is used for mining and milling purposes throughout the year.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
