CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, W. D. Parker has presented to the State Engineer

of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Unnamed Spring (Parker Spring)

through Pipe line and troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 Sec. 20, T. 33 N., R. 21 E., M.D.B. & M. or at a point which bears N. 30° 00' E., 1200 feet distant from the Southwest cor. of Sec. 20, T. 33 N., R. 21 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator W. D. Parker

Post-office address Gerlach, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0047 C.F.S. or sufficient to water 150 hd. of cattle and horses.

Period of use, from Jan. 1st to Dec. 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation February 25, 1926.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-

Water is developed at the spring in the SW 1/4 Sec. 20, T. 33 N., R. 21 E., M.D.B. & M., by an incline open cut 4 by 6 feet face and about 50 ft. long, from which water is diverted by means of 65 ft. of 1 1/2 inch iron pipe and stored in two galvanized iron troughs, each of 70 gallons capacity, where it is used for stockwatering purposes throughout the year.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
