CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, R. H. Cowles has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Missouri Creek through pipe line for

Stockwatering purposes.

The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the SE 1/4 Sec. 2, T. 29 N., R. 24 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point N. 60° 10' E., 1640 feet from the W 1/2 corner Sec. 2, T. 29 N., R. 24 E., M.D.B. & M.

situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of

1913, has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator R. H. Cowles

Post-office address Wadsworth, Washoe County, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.003 C.F.S. or sufficient to water 100 head of cattle

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation June 1, 1921

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

An open cut 30 feet long constructed at the point of diversion located in the SE 1/4 Sec. 2, T. 29 N., R. 24 E., from which water is conveyed through 100 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe to three redwood troughs 16 inches deep, 2 feet wide, and 16 feet long where it is used for the watering of 100 head of cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
