CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, George W. Smith has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Saviozzi Springs through Smith Ditch for Irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Approximately the SW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 4, T. 31 N., R. 59 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed, or at a point N. 63° 50' W., 5255 feet from corner No. 4, H.E.S. 159 T. 31 N., R. 59 E. MDM situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation: 0.570 C.F.S. or 189.60 acre feet per season
Period of use, from April 1 to September 15 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: May 31, 1921

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:
57.0 acres in H.E.S. No. 159, approximately Sec. 10, T. 31 N., R. 59 E., MDM
57.0 acres Total.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
