CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Henry Palma has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cerruti Well No. 2 through pump, pipeline and troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Approximately the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 17, T. 16N., R. 51E., M. D. B. & M., or at a point which bears S. 57° 05' E., 39600 ft distant from the NW Corner Sec. 29, T. 17 N., R. 50 E. M. D. B. & M. situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913

has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Henry Palma Sr., Henry Palma Jr., Louis Palma, and Areglio Palma

Post-office address: Eureka, Nevada

Amount of appropriation: 0.0375 C.F.S. or sufficient to water 6000 head

Period of use, from April 1st to December 1st of sheep of each year

Date of priority of appropriation: January 21, 1925.

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:

A well 40 feet deep has been dug, from which water is raised through pipe line by means of gasoline engine and pump, and conveyed through 40 ft. of 2 inch pipe to 75 ft. of iron troughs where it is used for stockwatering purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
