CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Betty O'Neal Mines by N.H. Getchell, Mgr. has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Whiskey Springs

through pipe line for Mining and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 27, T. 30 N., R. 45 E., M.D.B. & M.

situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913

has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Betty O'Neal Mines

Post-office address Battle Mountain, Lander County, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 022 of a cubic foot per second

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation August 30, 1920.

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:

The water is conveyed through 1760 feet of 4 inch pipe, and 1447 feet of 2 inch pipe from a catch basin and tunnel at the point of diversion located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 27, T. 30 N., R. 45 E., to a 50,000 gallon tank located in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 22, T. 30 N., R. 45 E., where it is used for mining and domestic purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
