CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Alex Dufferrena has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Diamond Spring through pipe line and troughs for Stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 Sec. 33, T. 46 N., R. 30 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Alex Dufferrena
Post-office address Denio, Oregon
Amount of appropriation 0.0094 C.F.S. or sufficient to water 1500 head of sheep.
Period of use, from April 1st to November 30th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 12, 1927.

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:-
A pool 10 ft. in diameter, 3 ft. deep has been dug at the spring in the SE 1/4 Sec. 33, T. 46 N., R. 30 E., M.D.B. & M., and water is conveyed from the pool by means of 4 ft of 1 1/2 inch pipe to 72 feet of 1 x 1 ft. wood and metal troughs.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
