CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Alex Dufferrena has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Texas Spring through pipe line and troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: at a point in the SE 1/4 Sec. 18, T. 45 N., R. 32 E., M.D.B. & M., which bears N. 49°05'E., 9910 ft. distant from corner Secs. 23, 24, 25, 26 of T. 45 N., R. 31 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Humboldt County, State of Nevada:

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Alex Dufferrena
Post-office address Denio, Oregon
Amount of appropriation 0.0094 C.F.S. or sufficient to water 1500 head of sheep
Period of use, from March 1st to November 30th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 12, 1927.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
100 ft. of 1 1/2 inch pipe diverts and conveys the water from Texas Spring in the SE 1/4 Sec. 18, T. 45 N., R. 32 E., M.D.B. & M., to 60 ft. of 1 x 1 1/2 ft. wooden troughs.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used; not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
