CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Geo. W. Young, Mgr. White Bear Syndicate has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Unnamed Spring (White Bear Syndicate Spring) through Pipe Line for Mining Milling and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the NW 1/4 Sec. 14, T. 33 N., R. 36 E., M.D.B. & M., or S. 82° 34' W., 1977 feet from NE corner Sec. 14, T. 33 N., R. 36 E., M.D.B. & M.

situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Mill City, Pershing County, Nevada.  
Amount of appropriation 0.00089 Cubic second feet  
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation May 19, 1924.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is conveyed through a 2 inch pipe line from the spring to a storage tank located in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Section 14, T. 33 N., R. 36 E., M.D.B. & M from where it is conveyed through a 2 inch pipe to a mill located in the same subdivision. Water is conveyed through a 1 inch pipe line leading out of the main pipe line to a boarding house and residence for domestic purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
