WHEREAS, Geo. W. Young, Mgr. White Bear Syndicate has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the NE 1/4 Sec. 11, T. 33 N., R. 36 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point S. 85°20'W., 540 feet from the East 1/4 corner Section 11, T. 33 N., R. 36 E., M.D.B. & M.

situated in Pershing County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 14C, Statutes of

1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator White Bear Syndicate

Post-office address Mill City, Pershing County, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0038 cubic second feet.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation May 19, 1924.

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is conveyed through a 1 1/2 inch pipe line from the point of diversion at the spring to a storage tank in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 section 11, T. 33 N., R. 36 E., M.D.B. & M., from where it is conveyed by pipeline to a mill located in the same subdivision and there used for milling and domestic purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
