CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, James Ryan has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Boulder Spring through Boulder Pipe line for Stockwatering and Domestic use

SE from Sec. 16, T. 7 S., R. 65 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed, or N. 70° 00' W., 52,800 ft. from the NW corner T. 8 S., R. 67 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 149, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriators James Ryan
Post-office address Caliente, Lincoln County, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.01 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 322 head of cattle and horses.
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation July 29, 1919.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is conveyed from the spring through 200 feet of 3 1/2 inch pipe; 700 feet of 2 1/2 inch pipe; 750 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe, and 12,500 feet of 2 inch pipe to a cement tank 3 feet wide 12 feet long, and 20 inches deep, located approximately in the NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 26, T. 7 S., R. 65 E., M.D.B. & M., where it is used for the watering of 300 head of cattle and 22 head of horses and mules.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
