CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Martin Etchemendy has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Marteletti Spring through Pipe line for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: approximately in the SW 1/4 Sec. 31, T. 11 N., R. 55 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed, or at a point S. 47° 16' W., 42,253.2 ft. from the SW corner T. 12 N., R. 56 E., M.D.B. & M.

situated in Nye County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Pedro Etchevery

Post-office address Eureka, Eureka County, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0219 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 3500 head of sheep

Period of use, from May 1 to December 1 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation April 12, 1918

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is conveyed from the spring through 120 feet of 2 inch pipe to three troughs 20 feet long, 2 feet wide, and 18 inches deep where it is used for the watering of 3500 head of sheep.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
