CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS John Yelland has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Four Mile Springs through ditch for Irrigation

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 27, T. 17 N., R. 68 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point which bears N. 58 30' E., 1660 feet from the West 1/4 corner Sec. 27, T. 17 N., R. 68 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from April 1st to Sept. 30th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 26, 1918.

3.04 acres in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 27, T. 17 N., R. 68 E., M.D.B. & M.
3.56 acres in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 28, T. 17 N., R. 68 E., M.D.B. & M.
6.60 acres Total.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
