CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS J. H. Smith has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from West Branch of Buffalo Creek through Ditch for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: at a point S. 10° 15' W., 575 feet from the NW corner of Sec. 9, T. 33 N., R. 19 E., or approximately in the NE 1/4 Sec. 8, T. 33 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

NOW KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator J. M. Ward and J. H. Smith  
Post-office address Reno, Washoe County, Nevada  
Amount of appropriation 0.0125 C.F.S. or sufficient to water 400 head of horses and cattle.  
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation May 6, 1925.

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is impounded in the channel of the creek by means of a low rock dam constructed at the point of diversion and also diverted to a ditch for stockwatering purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
