CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS J. H. Eager, Gen Mgr. The Adams McGill Co. has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Gleason Spring No. 2 through Pipe line for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the SW 1/4 Sec. 18, T. 18 N., R. 62 E., M.D.B. & M., or N. 1/4 Sec. 18, T. 18 N., R. 62 E., M.D.B. & M., 930 feet from the W 1/2 corner Sec. 18,

situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913

has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator The Adams McGill Company
Post-office address Ely, White Pine County, Nevada.
Amount of appropriation 0.019 C.F.S. or sufficient to water 2500 head of sheep, 100 head of cattle.
Period of use, from April 1 to September 30 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 11, 1922.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is diverted at the spring by means of an open cut 12 feet long, and conveyed through 20 feet of 1 inch iron pipe to 20 feet of 20 inch iron troughs where it is used for the watering of 2500 head of sheep and 100 head of cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
