CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Philip Brady has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cottonwood Spring through pipe to troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the NE-NE¹ Sec. 4, T. 28 N., R. 66 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point S. 4° 50' W., 1200 feet from the NE corner Sec. 4, T. 28 N., R. 66 E., M.D.B. & M.

situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72., Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Philip Brady
Post-office address Currie Elko County, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.015 C.F.S. or sufficient to water 2000 head of sheep and 100 head of cattle.
Period of use, from April 1 to November 1 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation December 19, 1924.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is conveyed through 40 feet of 3 inch pipe from the spring to four wooden troughs 12 inches by 12 inches by 12 feet where it is used for the watering of 2000 head of sheep and 100 head of cattle.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
