CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS John Uhalde has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cedar Spring through ditch, reservoir and troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 Sec. 33, T. 19 N., R. 61 E. M.D.B. & M., or at a point which bears N. 66° 15' E., 2880 feet from the South 1/4 corner Sec. 33, T. 19 N., R. 61 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator John Uhalde  
Post-office address Lily, White Pine County, Nevada  
Amount of appropriation 0.0125 C.F.S. or sufficient to water 2000 head of sheep  
Period of use, from June 1st to October 1st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation December 15, 1921.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-  
Water is developed by means of an open cut and conveyed through a ditch 60 feet long to an impounding reservoir 14 ft. x 14 ft. by 7 ft. deep, from where it is conveyed through 110 feet of 2 inch pipe to 84 feet of galvanized stock troughs and used for stockwatering purposes.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
