WHEREAS Clay Springs Cattle Co. by G. W. Hall has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

through pipe line for  
Stockwatering and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the SW 1/4 Sec. 22, T. 18 S., R. 56 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point S. 35° 25' E., 1795.6 feet from the NW corner Sec. 22, T. 18 S., R. 56 E., M.D.B. & M.

situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Clay Springs Cattle Company

Post-office address St. George, Utah

Amount of appropriation 0.0016 C.F.S. or sufficient to water 50 head of cattle and horses.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation October 23, 1917.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Water is conveyed from the spring through forty feet of one inch pipe to a wooden trough where it is used for the watering of fifty head of cattle and horses.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
