CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS G. W. Hail has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Dale Spring

through pipe line for Stockwatering and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the NW 1/4 Sec. 21, T. 18 S., R. 56 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point S. 57° 30' W., 1910.5 feet from the NE corner Sec. 21, T. 18 S., R. 56 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Clark County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Clay Springs Cattle Co.  
Post-office address St. George, Utah  
Amount of appropriation 0.0016 C.F.S. or sufficient to water 50 head of cattle  
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation October 23, 1917.

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is conveyed from the spring through forty feet of pipe to a wooden trough where it is used for the watering of 50 head of cattle.

The right to water hereby determined, is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
