CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS J. P. Wright has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Murphy Gap through Murphy tunnel for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 11 T. 2 S. R. 58 E. M.D.B. 31 situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: John Castles a 1/5 interest  
John P. Wright a 1/5 interest  
Post-office address: James Castles a 1/3 interest  
Hiko, Lincoln County, Nevada.  
Amount of appropriation: 0.0008 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 25 head of cattle  
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation: November 19, 1917

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a tunnel eighty feet long, four feet wide, and six feet high at the entrance of which a dam is constructed forming a reservoir where 25 head of cattle are watered.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
