Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of

1913

has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator John Castles a 1/2 interest John P. Wright a 1/2 interest

Post-office address Hiko, Lincoln County, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0008 c.f.s. or sufficient to water 25 head of cattle.

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation November 19, 1917

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is developed by means of a tunnel which is thirty-five feet long, four feet wide, and six feet high from where the water is conveyed to troughs twelve feet long and which were made by hewing out large logs placed at the mouth of the tunnel and at which point twenty-five head of cattle are watered.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
