

# THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Albert Williams has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Mill Spring through pipe line and tank for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 21, T. 14 N.; R. 60 E., M.D.B.&M. unsurveyed or at a point which bears N. 46° 30' E., 16,896 feet distant from the SW Cor. Sec. 31, T. 14 N.; R. 60 E., M.D.B.&M. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Albert Williams  
Post-office address Ely, Nevada  
Amount of appropriation .0012 of a cubic foot per second or sufficient to water 100 head of cattle.  
Period of use, from Mar. 1st to Nov. 30th of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation June 7, 1925

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Spring at the point of diversion has been developed by means of 100 feet of open cut, 6 feet wide and 12 feet in depth at upper end. With a collecting box 10 feet long, 2 1/2 feet wide, 1 1/2 feet deep from where water is conveyed through 90 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipeline to an iron tank 7 1/2 feet in diameter, 2 1/2 ft. high and having a concrete foundation.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
