CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, C.V. Taylor as agent for Everett F. Hill has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Mud Springs through reservoir for stockwatering

purposes: The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 12, T. 44 N; R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M., or at a point which bears N. 34° 16' W., 9716 ft. distant from the S. 1/4 Cor. Sec. 18, T. 44 N; R. 20 E., M.D.B.&M. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now Know Ye, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Everett F. Hill
Post-office address: Cedarville, California
Amount of appropriation: 0.01 C.F.S. or sufficient to water 300 cattle 15 horses.
Period of use, from: March 1st to Nov. 30st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: June 21, 1928

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:-
A reservoir 40 ft. in diameter and 5 feet deep has been excavated at the spring; located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 12, T. 44 N; R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M., in which water is impounded for the watering of livestock.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
