

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Louis H. Danberg has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Sage Hen Spring and Creek through trough and catch basin for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 5, T. 19 N; R. 36 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point which bears S. 45° 15' W., 1460 ft. from the NE Cor. Sec. 5, T. 19 N; R. 36 E. situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Myrtle and Louis H. Danberg
Post-office address Fallon, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.0038 C.F.S. or sufficient to water 500 head or sheep or 100 cattle.
Period of use, from Jan. 1st to Dec. 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 26, 1925

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:-
Two wooden troughs and series of catch basins located at the point of diversion impound water for watering range livestock.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
