CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, O.C. Dickinson has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Mountain Spring through pipeline and troughs for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Approximately NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 17, T. 23 N; R. 18 E. M.D.B.&M. fractional unsurveyed or at a point which bears N. 76°35' W. 6410 ft. from SW Cor. Sec. 15 same township and range. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.016 C.F.S. or sufficient to water 50 head of cattle.
Period of use, from Mar. 1st to Dec. 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 5, 1926

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Spring at point of diversion has been dug out and cribbed up.
Water is conveyed from Spring through 40 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe into one wooden trough 16 feet long, 12 inches wide, 12 inches deep, and one galvanized trough 8 feet long, 16 inches wide, 24 inches deep.
Works are located approximately in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 17, T. 23 N; R. 18 E; M.D.B.&M. fractional unsurveyed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
