CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS O.C. Dickinson has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Upper and Lower Willow Spring through pipeline and troughs for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows Approximately SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 16, T. 23 N; R. 18 E. M.D.B.&M. fractional unsurveyed or at points which bear N. 76° 30' W. 3985 feet and N. 83° 17' W. 3925 ft. from SW Cor. Sec. 15. same township and range. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0019 C.F.S. or sufficient to water 60 head of cattle.
Period of use, from Mar. 1st to Dec. 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 5, 1926.

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:
From Upper Willow Spring water is diverted and conveyed through 22 feet of one inch galvanized pipe into a galvanized trough 16 inches x 24 inches x 8 feet long.
At lower Willow Spring a cut 25 feet long has been made and water is conveyed through 22 feet of one inch pipe into a wooden trough 14 inches by 14 inches by 16 feet long. Works are located approximately in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 16, T. 23 N; R. 18 E. M.D.B.&M. fractional unsurveyed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
