

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS O.C. Dickinson has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Fred's Spring through pipeline and troughs for stockwatering purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 5, T. 22 N; R. 19 E. M.D.B.&M. or at a point which bears S. 74° 10' E. 1665 feet from the NW Cor. Sec. 5, same township and range. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.003 C.F.S. or sufficient to water 100 head of cattle.
Period of use, from Mar. 1st to Dec. 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation April 19, 1926.

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Spring has been dug out and walled up with rock. From the spring water is conveyed through 44 feet of one inch pipe, 44 feet of 3/4 inch pipe into three wooden troughs 16 feet long 14 inches wide and 14 inches deep and 2 galvanized iron troughs 8 feet long 16 inches wide and 24 inches deep. Works are located in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 5, T. 22 N; R. 19 E. M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
