CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Handley Brothers by H.M. Payne has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Unnamed Spring (Handley Bros., Spring) through Handley Dam and reservoir for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 22, T. 20 N. R. 55 E. M.D.B.&M. or at a point which bears N. 16deg. 12' 10" E., 7236.88 feet from South 1/4 Cor. Sec. 27 same township and range. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: Handley Brothers
Post-office address: Eureka, Eureka County, Nevada.
Amount of appropriation: 0.034 C.F.S. or sufficient to water 5000 sheep, 25 horses and 60 cattle.
Period of use, from Jan. 1st to Dec. 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: November 5, 1919.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from the spring by means of a dam 50 feet long and 3 feet high. The natural channel has been cleaned out and used as a ditch for conveying water easterly about 250 feet to a reservoir approximately 500 feet long, 50 to 150 feet wide and 3 to 5 feet deep. The reservoir is located in NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 22 and NW 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 23 of T. 20 N; R. 55 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
