CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, C. E. Kent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Lee's West Canyon Springs through pipeline and troughs for Stockwatering and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Approximately NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 32, T. 20 N; R. 33 E. M.D.B.&M. unsurveyed or at a point which bears N. 83deg. 07' E. 43,339 ft. from SW. Cor. Sec. 36, T. 20 N; R. 31 E., M.D.B.&M. situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator C. E. Kent
Post-office address Stillwater, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.05 C.F.S. or sufficient to water 3000 sheep and 1000 cattle.
Period of use, from Jan. 1st to Dec. 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation October 7, 1925

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Spring has been developed by digging a sump hole from which water is diverted through 5 feet of 1 1/2 inch pipe into 5 wooden troughs each 12 inches wide, 12 inches deep and 8 feet long. Works located approximately NW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 32, T. 20 N; R. 33 E., M.D.B.&M. unsurveyed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
