CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Angelo DeBernardi has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Robinson Spring through DeBernardi Ditches for Irrigation and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Lot 1, Sec. 3, T. 20 N; R. 55 E. M.D.B.&M. or at a point which bears S. 82deg 23' W. 991 feet from NE Cor. Sec. 3, same township and range. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation: 0.373 C.F.S. or 181 acre feet for the season.
Period of use, from Mar. 1st to Nov. 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: October 6, 1924

Description of land to which water is appurtenant:
3.2 acres in Lot 1, Sec. 3, T. 20 N; R. 55 E., M.D.B.&M.
1.7 acres in the SE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 3, T. 20 N; R. 55 E., M.D.B.&M.
31.0 acres in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 2, T. 20 N; R. 55 E., M.D.B.&M.
1.4 acres in Lot. 4, Sec. 2, T. 20 N; R. 55 E., M.D.B.&M.
37.3 acres total.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
