

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. P. Raine has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Rock Springs through Reservoir, pipeline and troughs for Stockwatering and Domestic purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 34, T. 31 N; R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M. situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE. That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator J. P. Raine
Post-office address Reno, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.015 C.F.S. or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle.
Period of use, from Jan. 1st to Dec. 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 18, 1925

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Spring has been developed and walled up with rock. Water is diverted by means of 7 feet of 2 inch pipe into two watering troughs, each 15 feet long. Works located in the NE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 34, T. 31 N; R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
