CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. P. Raine has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Cherry Springs

through pipeline and troughs for Stackwatering and domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 16, T. 29 N; R. 51 E. M.D.B.&M. or at a point which bears N. 46deg. 21' E. 800 feet from W 1/4 Cor. Sec. 16, same township and range.

situated in Eureka County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator J. P. Raine

Post-office address Reno, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.015 C.F.S. or sufficient to water 500 head of cattle.

Period of use, from Jan. 1st to Dec. 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation March 18, 1925.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:

Springs have been developed and fenced. A small impounding reservoir has been dug out at the springs, and a two inch pipe 8 feet long conveys water from the reservoir into 2 watering troughs each 15 feet long. The troughs are connected by a 2 inch pipe 12 inches long.

Works are located in the SW 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 16, T. 29 N; R. 51 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
