

# THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Lyle Cook has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Unnamed Spring (Cook Spring) through pipeline and troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 14, T. 35 N; R. 19 E. M.D.B.&M. or at a point which bears N 9deg. 30' E. 1930 feet from the South 1/4 Cor. Sec. 14, same township and range. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE. That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Lyle Cook  
Post-office address Eagleville, California  
Amount of appropriation 0.003 C.F.S. or sufficient to water 100 cattle.  
Period of use, from Mar. 1st to Nov. 1st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation June 19, 1926

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Water is diverted and conveyed from spring by means of 100 feet of one inch pipe into 20 feet of galvanized troughs. Works are located in the NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 14, T. 35 N; R. 19 E., M.D.B.&M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
