CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, Lyle Cook has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Burnt Lake Canon Spring through pipeline and troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows Approximately NE 1/4 Sec. 16, T. 35 N; R. 19 E. unsurveyed or at a point which bears N. 54 deg. 30' W. 7950 ft. from the SW. Cor. Sec. 14, T. 35 N; R. 19 E. M.D.B.&M. situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE. That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator Lyle Cook
Post-office address Eagleville, California
Amount of appropriation 0.02 C.F.S. or sufficient to water 2000 sheep, 200 cattle & 50 horses.
Period of use, from Jan. 1st to Dec. 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 20, 1928.

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:
Water is diverted from spring into 32 feet of galvanized troughs, by means of 20 feet of one inch pipe. Works are located approximately in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 unsurveyed Sec. 16, T. 35 N; R. 19 E.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
