

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, John Hickison has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Twin Springs through pipeline, tank and ditches for Irrigation and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 12, T. 22 N; R. 47 E., M.D.B.&M. or at a point which bears S. 63 1/2 W., 2460 feet from E 1/4 Cor. Sec. 12, same township and range. situated in Lander County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1915 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.02 C.F.S. or 8.5 acre feet for the season.
Period of use, from April 1st to Nov. 1st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation June 16, 1926

Description of irrigated land to which water is appurtenant:
2 acres in the NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 12, T. 22 N; R. 47 E., M.D.B.&M.
2 acres total.

Note: Permit No. 7893 was granted to change the point of diversion and place of use under permit No. 7777, hence the priority of the water right hereunder relates back to the filing of application No. 7777.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
