CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, MRS. ALICE CARTER has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Unnamed Spring (Carter Spring)

through pipe line and trough for Stock Watering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 29, T. 11 N., R. 63 E., M. D. B. & M.

situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator ALICE CARTER

Post-office address Lund, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.003 cfs or sufficient to water 100 head of cattle

Period of use, from April 1 to November 1 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation October 21, 1914

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:-

Water is diverted from spring by means of 20 feet of 3/4" pipe into galvanized watering troughs.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
