

THE STATE OF NEVADA
CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, B. F. Rogers has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Willow Spring

through pipe line and troughs for Stockwatering and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Approximately SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 13, T. 4 N., R. 38 E., M.D.B.M., unsurveyed, or at a point which bears S. 89° 54' W., 12825 feet from the NE corner of Sec. 1, same township and range, Esmeralda County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator: ROGER BROTHERS
Post-office address: Round Mountain, Nevada
Amount of appropriation: 0.02 cfs or sufficient to water 600 head of cattle following
Period of use, from: November 1 to June 1 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: January 28, 1925

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:--
Water is piped direct from spring by means of two pipes, one about 200 feet long and one about 10 feet long, leading into three troughs, one trough being of the dimensions 20 feet long by 2-1/2 feet wide; one trough about 10 feet long by 2-1/2 feet wide, and one trough 10 feet long by 3 feet wide.

Note:-- Permit No. 8023 was granted to change the manner of use of water under Permit No. 7292, hence the priority of the water right hereunder dates back to the filing of Application No. 7292.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
