purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SW 1/4 Sec. 8, T. 39 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point which bears N. 74° 55' E., 2460 feet from the SW corner of Sec. 8, T. 39 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M.

situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

2500 sheep and 100 cattle

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation October 7, 1929

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-

An excavation has been made at the spring and walled with rock, from which water is conveyed through 15 feet of 2 inch pipe into a watering trough 2 feet wide, 2 feet deep and 14 feet long. Works are located in the SE 1/4 SW 1/4 of Sec. 8, T. 39 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M.
