

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. P. Saffores, by C. V. Taylor, has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from

Willow Springs
through small dams and reservoirs for

Stockwatering

purposes: The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 NW 1/4 Sec. 9, T. 39 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point which bears S. 57° 55' E., 2750 feet from the NW corner of Sec. 9, T. 39 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M.

situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of

1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Post-office address Gerlach, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.019 cfs., or sufficient to water 2500 sheep
and 100 cattle

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year

Date of priority of appropriation October 7, 1929

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-

Three rock and earth dams have been constructed immediately below and across the channel leading easterly from the spring. The dams 15 feet long and 2-1/2 feet high form small reservoirs, where water is impounded for the watering of livestock. Works are located in the SE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 9, T. 39 N., R. 19 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
