

THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, J. P. Saffores, by C. V. Taylor has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Ant Spring through pipe line and trough for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 13, T. 39 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point which bears S. 66° 10' W., 1740 feet from the quarter corner on the east boundary of Sec. 13, T. 39 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B. & M., Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.009 cfs, or sufficient to water 1500 sheep
Period of use, from January 1st to December 13th of each year
Date of priority of appropriation November 27, 1929

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-
Spring is rocked up and water is conveyed therefrom through 10 feet of 2 inch pipe into a galvanized trough 2'x2'x14' long. Works located in NW 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 13, T. 39 N., R. 18 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
