CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS C. E. Kent has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Buck Brush Spring through pipe line and trough for Stockwatering and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: Approximately in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 4, T. 18 N., R. 33 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed, or at a point which bears S. 14° 45' E., 36,100 feet from Corner No. 1 of David Sanford's possessory claim, situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator KENT LAND & LIVESTOCK COMPANY
Post-office address Fallon, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.015 cfs, or sufficient to water 1500 sheep and 200 cattle
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation May 3, 1929

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-
Water is diverted from the spring through 12 feet of 1-1/2 inch pipe into watering trough 1 foot wide, 1 foot deep and 6 feet 9 inches long. Overflow from trough is impounded in several small earthen reservoirs. Works are located approximately in the NW 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 4, T. 18 N., R. 33 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
