CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, C.C. Everett, P.G. Lofthouse and R. J. Lofthouse have presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Deer Lodge Spring through pipe line and troughs for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 15, T. 21 N., R. 37 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point which bears N. 25° 30' E., 2350 feet from the SW corner of Section 15, T. 21 N., R. 37 E., M.D.B. & M., situated in Churchill County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation: 0.003 cfs, or sufficient to water 50 cattle and 50 horses
Period of use, from: January 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation: December 12, 1925

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-

Water is conveyed from the spring through 8 feet of 2 inch pipe into two galvanized iron troughs, each 8 feet long, 12 inches wide on the bottom, 15 inches wide on top and 12 inches deep. Works are located in the NW 1/4 of the SW 1/4 of Section 15, T. 21 N., R. 37 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
