purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 23, T. 21 N., R. 37 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point which bears N. 29° 10' E., 970 feet from the SW corner of Section 23, T. 21 N., R. 37 E., M.D.B. & M. Churchill County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.003 cfs, or sufficient to water 50 cattle and 50 horses  
Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation December 12, 1925

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-  
Water is conveyed from spring through 8 feet of two inch pipe into two galvanized iron troughs, each 8 feet long, 12 inches wide on the bottom and 15 inches wide on top, with a depth of 12 inches. Works are located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 23, T. 21 N., R. 37 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
