CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS S. C. Durkee, State Highway Engineer has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Little Six Mile Creek Spring through pump and wooden water tank for Highway Maintenance and General Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 NE 1/4 Section 29, T. 37 N., R. 66 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point which bears N. 27° 20' W., 3,243 feet from the SE corner of Section 29, T. 37 N., R. 66 E., M.D.B. & M., situated in Elko County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from January 1st to December 31st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation May 26, 1925

Description of Works of diversion, manner and place of use:-  
During the winter months water is pumped from spring into a fifteen hundred gallon wooden tank, situated adjacent to spring. During the summer water is taken directly from the pump. Use of water is for highway maintenance and general domestic use, including use for the traveling public. Works are located in the SW 1/4 NE 1/4 of Section 29, T. 37 N., R. 66 E., M.D.B. & M.

Compared P. C. A. J. P. M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
