CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS Donly Gray has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Shallow Well or Spring

through pipe line and trough for Stockwatering and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Sec. 16, T. 26 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point which bears S. 65° 49' W., 1,360 feet from closing of Sections 9 and 16, T. 26 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M. on the west boundary of Pyramid Lake Indian Reservation.
situated in Washoe County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source,

purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation .001 cfs, for 10 head of horses and domestic use
Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year
Date of priority of appropriation September 13, 1927

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-
Water is conveyed from the spring through 20 feet of one inch pipe into one half round iron trough 10' x 1'. Works are located in the NE 1/4 NW 1/4 of Section 16, T. 26 N., R. 20 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
