Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of \_\_\_\_\_ 1913 \_\_\_\_\_ has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Period of use, from April 1st to October 31st of each year

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:  
Well 4'x4'x65 feet deep, mine timbered to its entire depth, with 8"x8" sets and 2"x12" lagging. Installed 3 cylinder Hayes Horsepower Pump and 200 feet of 20" corrugated steel troughs. Water is conveyed from pump to trough through 10 feet of 2" pipe. Works are located in the NE $\frac{1}{4}$  NE $\frac{1}{4}$  of Section 30, T. 17 N., R. 62 E., M.D.B. & M.

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The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
