CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS C. R. Moorman has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Wild Horse Spring through pipeline, troughs and reservoir for stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: NE 1/4 NE 1/4 Sec. 21, T. 17 N., R. 58 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point which bears S. 75° 50' W., 22,240 ft. from the NE corner of Sec. 18, T. 17 N., R. 59 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now Know YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator C. R. MOORMAN
Post-office address Ely, Nevada
Amount of appropriation 0.003 cfs, or sufficient to water 100 head of cattle
Period of use, from April 1st to December 31st of each year
Date of priority of appropriation March 30, 1927

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-
Water is conveyed from spring through 200 feet of one inch pipe into 30 feet of galvanized troughs and a reservoir 12 feet x 30 feet. Works are located in the NE 1/4 NE 1/4 of Sec. 21, T. 17 N., R. 58 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
