

# THE STATE OF NEVADA CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS, C. R. Moorman has presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Halsteads Creek through reservoir for Stockwatering

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 11, T. 17 N., R. 58 E., M.D.B. & M., or at a point which bears N. 88° 30' W., 11,700 feet from the NE corner of Sec. 18, T. 17 N., R. 59 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in White Pine County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1913 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Amount of appropriation 0.0078 cfs. or sufficient to water 250 head of cattle  
Period of use, from April 1st to December 31st of each year  
Date of priority of appropriation March 30, 1927

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use:-  
An earth and rock dam 100 ft. long, 4 ft. high has been constructed across the channel of the creek, forming a reservoir 80 ft. in diameter for the watering of livestock. Works are located in the SE 1/4 SE 1/4 Sec. 11, T. 17 N., R. 58 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
