CERTIFICATE OF APPROPRIATION OF WATER

WHEREAS James Ryan and John H. Conaway have presented to the State Engineer of the State of Nevada Proof of Application of Water to Beneficial Use, from Abandoned Spring

through pipe line and trough for Stockwatering and Domestic

purposes. The point of diversion of water from the source is as follows: SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 20, T. 5 S., R. 64 E., M.D.B. & M., unsurveyed, or at a point which bears S. 17° 00' E., 21,120 feet the SE corner of T. 4 S., R. 63 E., M.D.B. & M. situated in Lincoln County, State of Nevada.

Now KNOW YE, That the State Engineer, under the provisions of Section 72, Chapter 140, Statutes of 1915 has determined the date, source, purpose and amount of such appropriation, together with the place to which such water is appurtenant, as follows:

Name of appropriator JAMES RYAN and JOHN H. CONAWAY

Post-office address Caliente, Nevada

Amount of appropriation 0.0016 cfs, or sufficient to water 50 head of cattle

Period of use, from January 1 to December 31 of each year

Date of priority of appropriation May 24, 1929

Description of works of diversion, manner and place of use: Water is conveyed from spring through 100 feet of 3/4 inch pipe into galvanized trough 3 feet wide, 3 feet deep, 10 feet long inside of wooden trough. Works are located in the SW 1/4 SW 1/4 of Section 20, T. 5 S., R. 64 E., M.D.B. & M.

The right to water hereby determined is limited to the amount which can be beneficially used, not to exceed the amount above specified, and the use is restricted to the place where acquired and to the purpose for which acquired.
